Horrible Lab Habits at Hogwarts

Professor Lupin warned them to be careful and reminded them to follow the safety rules they had learned in class. The professor passed out the materials and provided each person with a <u>Properties of a Mystery</u> <u>Substance Lab</u> directions packet. Parvati and Neville flipped through the packet and decided to start the experiment right away. Since the teacher did not tell them to wear the safety goggles, they left them on the table.

Parvati reached across the table to grab a test tube from Neville and knocked over a bottle of the mystery substance, a little bit splashed on Neville. Neville thought it smelled weird so he took a deep whiff of it. He didn't think it smelled poisonous and tasted a little bit of the substance. Meanwhile, Parvarti began mopping up the spill she made with her shirt so the teacher would not see she had spilled.

Ron read the directions for the mystery substance lab, so he put on some safety goggles. He was curious about what would happen if he mixed different substances.
